<p><b>SURGICAL OUTCOMES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- INSERTION OF A BLADDER CATHETER</li> <li>- BLEEDING REQUIRING RETURN TO THEATRE</li> <li>- WOUND INFECTION/HERNIA REQUIRING FURTHER TREATMENT</li> <li>- LYMPHOCELE REQUIRING RADIOLOGICAL OR SURGICAL INTERVENTION</li> <li>- URETERIC STRICTURE REQUIRING RADIOLOGICAL OR SURGICAL INTERVENTION OR PERMANENT STENT INSERTION.</li> <li>- URINARY LEAK REQUIRING PROLONGED BLADDER CATHETERISATION AND/OR RADIOLOGICAL OR SURGICAL INTERVENTION</li> <li>- INSERTION OF STENT WITH FURTHER PROCEDURE TO REMOVE IT</li> </ul> <p><b>TRANSPLANT COMPLICATIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- FAILURE FOR KIDNEY TO WORK REQUIRING CONTINUED DIALYSIS AND/OR LATER REMOVAL OF KIDNEY</li> <li>- DELAYED FUNCTION OF NEW KIDNEY REQUIRING PROLONGED DIALYSIS</li> <li>- KIDNEY THROMBOSIS OR RUPTURE REQUIRING SURGICAL REMOVAL</li> <li>- ACUTE AND CHRONIC REJECTION REQUIRING RENAL BIOPSY (OPEN OR CLOSED) AND FURTHER IMMUNOSUPPRESSION TREATMENT WITH POSSIBLE LOSS OF KIDNEY</li> </ul>	<p><b>IMMUNOSUPPRESSION RELATED COMPLICATIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- LONG TERM IMMUNOSUPPRESSION DRUGS REQUIRED</li> <li>- SIDE EFFECTS OF DRUGS INCLUDE: TREMOR, LIVER PROBLEMS, RENAL PROBLEMS, HIRSUTISM, GUM ENLARGEMENT, HIGH CHOLESTEROL, STOMACH ULCERATION, BONE MARROW SUPPRESSION, DIABETES, OSTEOPOROSIS, POOR WOUND HEALING, CATARACTS, ALOPECIA, WT GAIN, HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE</li> <li>- LONG TERM IMMUNOSUPPRESSION IS ASSOCIATED WITH INCREASED RISK OF SOLID, BLOOD AND SKIN CANCERS IN THE FUTURE.</li> <li>- INCREASED RISK OF ALL TYPES OF INFECTIONS</li> </ul> <p><b>LEG COMPLICATIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- RARELY, PERSISTENT SWELLING OF LEG</li> <li>- DECREASED BLOOD SUPPLY TO LEG OCCASIONALLY REQUIRING SURGERY/ AMPUTATION</li> </ul> <p><b>GENERAL COMPLICATIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- URINARY INFECTION REQUIRING ANTIBIOTIC TREATMENT</li> <li>- RECURRENCE OF ORIGINAL DISEASE IN NEW KIDNEY</li> <li>- A TRANSPLANT DOES NOT CURE THE ORIGINAL DISEASE AND THEY MAY NOT WORK FOR EVER</li> </ul>
