COMMON

OCCASIONAL

- FAILURE TO IMPROVE URINARY INCONTINENCE
- RECURRENCE OF URINARY INCONTINENCE AT LATER TIME
- RECURRING BLADDER INFECTIONS DUE TO POOR EMPTYING OF BLADDER
- INFECTION OF INCISION REQUIRING FURTHER TREATMENT

RARE

- WORSENING OF FREQUENCY AND URGENCY OF URINATION
- RETENTION OF URINE REQUIRING PROLONGED CATHETERIZATION OR SELF-CATHETERIZATION
- DISCOMFORT FROM SLING IN VAGINA
- REACTION TO SLING MATERIAL (INFLAMMATION, INFECTION OR ALLERGIC) REQUIRING REMOVAL
- IF SEXUALLY ACTIVE, DISCOMFORT WITH SEXUAL INTERCOURSE

ALTERNATIVE THERAPY: OBSERVATION, PHYSIOTHERAPY, PADS, INJECTION THERAPY COLPOSUSPENSION AND OPEN SLING OPERATION.
